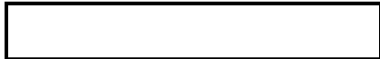

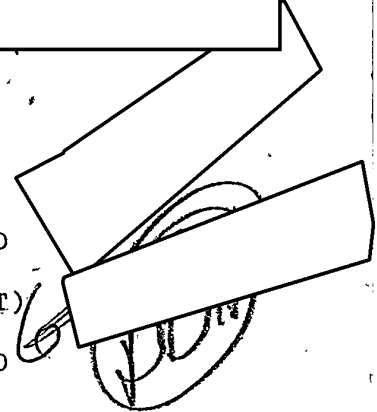
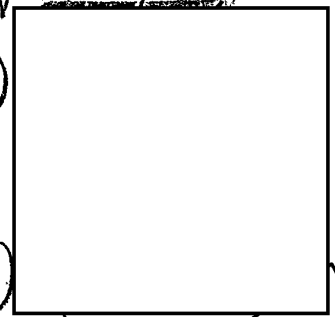

[redacted] advised that he was a passenger aboard the ACHILLE LAURO assigned to Cabin [redacted]. He stated that on the morning of October 7, 1985, he was returning to the ship with a group of passengers after completing a short shopping trip at the Port of Alexandria, Egypt. [redacted] advised that he and his [redacted] had elected not to join a large group of the ship's passengers for a bus trip to Cairo, Egypt, as they had previously visited this part of Egypt during a trip in 1979.

Upon boarding the ship after the shopping trip [redacted] his wife and other passengers from his group were in the main dining room having lunch. At approximately 11:30 a.m., [redacted] stated that he heard noises and gun shots. [redacted] observed four armed men in the dining room along with several other passengers and crew members. The four men, who [redacted] believed were armed with sub-machine guns, told everyone in the dining room to get down on the floor.

[redacted] advised that he heard loud groaning noises, and he was told by another passenger that two crew members had been shot. Shortly thereafter two of the armed men (here and after referred to as terrorists) came into the area of the dining room near a staircase shouting for benzine. A few minutes later several crew members arrived carrying large plastic containers filled with a substance that [redacted] believed to be petrol of some type.

Two of the terrorists remained with the group of passengers in the dining room while the other terrorists were rounding up crew members and passengers. [redacted] advised that additional members of the crew were brought into the dining room. After several hours in the dining

room the 12 Americans were taken to the Arazzui Lounge, which is three or four decks above the dining room. The Americans were kept in one area of this lounge adjacent to which was an area where five English girls were held. [REDACTED] recalled that the terrorists determined who were the Americans by requesting an individual's passport or, if it was not available, demanding his nationality. According to [REDACTED] there were two additional Americans on board the ship with diplomatic passports who hid their passports and claimed to be Austrians. [REDACTED] identified the Americans held with him as MARILYN and LEON KLINGHOFFER,

He stated that the crew did what they could to help the Americans and that on Monday evening brought them sandwiches, coffee and fruit. [REDACTED] advised that one particular terrorist, who may have been the leader, was particularly "nasty" and shouted "REAGAN no good, ARAFAT good".

On Tuesday the crew advised [REDACTED] and the others that they were proceeding to Syria and informed them when they were near the Port of Tartus. At approximately 11:00 a.m., on Tuesday, 11 of the Americans, 5 English girls and a couple of Austrian Jews were taken to a green metal deck 15 feet below the Captain's bridge. [REDACTED] explained that LEON KLINGHOFFER was left alone in a wheelchair in the lounge. [REDACTED] described KLINGHOFFER as a stroke victim with one arm useless and whose speech was very difficult to understand.

While on the metal deck, two containers of gasoline were placed with the hostages, and the caps of the containers were removed. [REDACTED] stated that a hat was knocked off his head and that he was told, along with the other individuals wearing eyeglasses, to place them on the deck. He described one of the terrorists as tall with a mustache and wearing a sweat shirt with "MEN" across the front. This sweat shirt was further described as having Arab words and symbols on the sleeves.

[REDACTED] recalled that they remained in this area for about three hours after which the Americans and the other individuals were taken back to the lounge and segregated as before into separate groups. [REDACTED] advised

that LEON KLINGHOFFER was no longer in the lounge, and he and some of the other passengers began making inquiries as to his whereabouts. At this point various passengers were being allowed to return to their rooms unescorted, and [REDACTED] was able to secure additional clothing for his wife and himself.

[REDACTED] was shown a schematic of the ACHILLE LAURO's decks, and he identified the location where the Americans were held along with where the guard was stationed.

KLINGHOFFER's wife was not permitted by the terrorists to go to the ship's hospital to see him. At approximately 4:00 p.m., on Tuesday the terrorist, who [REDACTED] believed may have been the leader, took the 11 Americans to an area of the ship he described as a childrens' playground. The Americans remained in that location until approximately 6:00 p.m., after which they were returned to the same area of the lounge where they had been previously kept. On Tuesday evening [REDACTED] stated that the crew informed the Americans that they were near Port Said, Egypt. [REDACTED] identified [REDACTED] as having conversations with his waiter concerning the terrorists' locations on the ship. He provided [REDACTED] address as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] telephone number AN3-6615.

[REDACTED] stated that no attempt had been made by the terrorists to identify any passenger with a Jewish background.

[REDACTED] advised that he will provide the FBI with film from his wife's camera which contain pictures of a section of the ship where blood stains were observed. It was [REDACTED] opinion that this was the location where KLINGHOFFER was killed. [REDACTED] also stated he would provide the FBI with a copy of an eight-page statement he wrote after his release.

ON OCTOBER 12, 1985, MARILYN KLINGHOFFER, 70 EAST 10TH STREET, NEW YORK, NEW YORK, 10003, APARTMENT 10J/K, ADVISED AS FOLLOWS:

SHE AND HER HUSBAND, LEON C. KLINGHOFFER, DOB SEPTEMBER 24, 1916, UNITED STATES CITIZEN BY BIRTH, WHO WAS CONFINED TO A WHEEL-CHAIR, WERE PASSENGERS ON THE ACHILLE LAURO WHEN, DURING LUNCH IN THE MAIN DINING ROOM ON A DAY EARLY IN THE WEEK, SHE WAS NOT SURE WHICH, SHE HEARD SHOTS FIRED IN THE KITCHEN AND THE KITCHEN STAFF BEGAN FILING OUT WITH THEIR HANDS OVER THEIR HEADS. SHE HEARD A MAN MOANING IN THE KITCHEN FOR ABOUT AN HOUR AFTER THE SHOTS WERE FIRED AND ASSUMED THAT HE HAD BEEN WOUNDED. THREE MEN WERE WITH THE STAFF AS THEY CAME OUT OF THE KITCHEN AND THEY HAD MACHINE GUNS WITH SHOULDER STRAPS. THEY ALSO HAD GRENADES. THEY ORDERED AN AREA CLEARED IN THE CENTER OF THE DINING ROOM AND EVERYONE WAS KEPT THERE FOR TWO TO THREE HOURS. THE THREE MEN WITH GUNS WERE SHOUTING AT THEM IN WHAT WAS BELIEVED TO BE ARABIC AND GIVING ORDERS IN POOR

ENGLISH. DURING THIS TIME, ONE AUSTRIAN MAN WAS HIT ACROSS THE CHEST. ALTOGETHER ABOUT FOUR HUNDRED PEOPLE WERE GATHERED IN THE DINING ROOM.

AFTER TWO TO THREE HOURS IN THE DINING ROOM, THEY WERE ORDERED TO THE ARETZI (PHONETIC) (PH) LOUNGE WHERE THEY WERE AGAIN KEPT IN A TIGHT GROUP IN ONE PART OF THE LOUNGE. THE VERBAL ABUSE IN ARABIC CONTINUED AND THE HIJACKERS PUT CANS OF BENZINE, EACH ABOUT TWO AND HALF TO THREE FEET HIGH, AROUND THEM IN A CIRCLE. SOMETIME DURING ALL OF THIS, THE THREE WERE JOINED BY A FOURTH HIJACKER. IT WAS HERE, WITH ONE EXCEPTION WHEN THEY WERE BROUGHT UP ON DECK, THAT THEY STAYED DURING THE REMAINDER OF THE HIJACKING. THEY SLEPT ON THE FLOOR AND THE CREW WAS ALLOWED TO BRING FOOD AND BLANKETS TO THEM. THE HIJACKERS TAUNTED THE PASSENGERS BY PULLING THE PINS ON THEIR GRENADES AND WAVING THEM.

IN THE BEGINNING, THE HIJACKERS ASKED IF ANYONE WAS JEWISH AND ONE AUSTRIAN COUPLE SAID YES. THEY RECEIVED A LOT OF VERBAL ABUSE BECAUSE OF THIS FROM THE HIJACKERS. THE KLINGHOFFER'S DID NOT SAY THEY WERE JEWISH AND BELIEVED THE HIJACKERS HAD NO WAY OF KNOWING

WHO WAS. LATER THEY ASKED WHO THE AMERICANS WERE AND THE AMERICANS IDENTIFIED THEMSELVES. THEY WERE THEN SEGREGATED. THE REST OF THE PASSENGERS SEEMED TO GROUP UP BY NATIONALITY, THE ITALIANS, THE GERMANS, ETC., WITHIN THE SMALL AREA THEY WERE ALL CONFINED TO. THERE WERE TEN TO TWELVE AMERICANS, AND KEPT NEARBY WERE SIX BRITISH-DANCING GIRLS WHO PERFORMED ON THE SHIP. AT TIMES, THEY WERE ALL MADE TO CHANT TOGETHER "ARAFAT YES, AMERICA NO, REAGAN TERRIBLE."

THE CAPTAIN CAME DOWN TO THE LOUNGE A FEW TIMES TO TALK TO THE PASSENGERS BUT NEVER CAME OVER TO THE AMERICAN GROUP. HE MADE SEVERAL ANNOUNCEMENTS AT TIMES OVER THE PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM ALSO TO TRY AND CALM THE PASSENGERS.

THE HIJACKERS NEVER SAID WHAT ORGANIZATION THEY BELONG TO OR WHAT THEY WANTED. AT ONE POINT ONE SAID "ME PALESTINIAN, ME GOOD. YOU AMERICAN, NO GOOD. YOU BRITISH, NO GOOD." SHE DID NOT KNOW WHICH OF THEM WAS IN CHARGE. AT ONE POINT, THEY TOOK THE JEWELRY FROM SEVERAL PASSENGERS, INCLUDING HER HUSBAND'S WATCH AND GAVE IT TO ONE OF THE HIJACKERS WITH THE BEARD. THE REST WERE CLEAN-SHAVEN. THE BEARDED HIJACKER LATER GAVE HER HUSBAND'S WATCH BACK TO HIM.

WHEN THEY WERE 15 TO 20 MILES, HER ESTIMATE, OFF THE SYRIAN COAST, THE AMERICANS AND BRITISH GIRLS WERE ORDERED UP ON DECK. MRS. KLINGHOFFER PUSHED HER HUSBAND'S WHEELCHAIR WITH THE GROUP TO THE STAIRS. AT THIS POINT, ONE OF THE HIJACKERS SAID HE (MR. KLINGHOFFER) CANNOT GO UP THE STAIRS AND TO LEAVE HIM THERE. SHE WENT UP WITHOUT HIM.

THEY WERE BROUGHT TO AN AREA BELOW THE BRIDGE OF THE SHIP WHERE THEY SPREAD THE AMERICANS AND BRITISH OUT ACROSS THE DECK AREA AND PUT CANS OF BENZINE AROUND AND AMONG THEM, REMOVING THE TOPS OFF THE CANS.

IT APPEARED THE HIJACKERS TOOK A LIKING TO THE BRITISH GIRLS AND THEY WOULD WALK OVER TO THEM AND DROP HALF SMOKED CIGARETTES IN FRONT OF THEM, ALLOWING THEM TO PICK THEM UP AND SMOKE. THE AMERICANS WERE NOT ALLOWED TO SMOKE. THE ENTIRE GROUP WAS MADE TO SIT UP STRAIGHT, WHICH WAS UNCOMFORTABLE FOR THE ELDERLY PEOPLE.

AFTER ABOUT ONE TO ONE AND A HALF HOURS, WHILE SITTING ON THE LEFT SIDE OF THE SHIP IN THE GROUP, SHE HEARD TWO SHOTS AND A SPLASH AS THOUGH SOMETHING HIT THE WATER. SHE REMEMBERS AT THAT MOMENT LOOKING UP AND SEEING THE CAPTAIN ON THE BRIDGE LOOKING DOWN AT HER.

THEY REMAINED SITTING ON THAT DECK FOR ANOTHER HOUR, STILL HAVING TO SIT UP STRAIGHT. SHE AT ONE POINT PLACED HER HANDBAG BEHIND HER TO LEAN BACK ON FOR SUPPORT BUT THEY ORDERED HER TO REMAIN UPRIGHT. AT THE TIME SHE HEARD THE SHOTS, THREE OUT OF THE FOUR HIJACKERS WERE PRESENT ON THE DECK GUARDING THEM. THE FOURTH, THE ONLY ONE WITH A BEARD AND MUSTACHE, WAS MISSING. SHE BELIEVES HE WAS CALLED [REDACTED] (PH). SHE IS NOT SURE OF THE NAMES OF THE OTHERS. WHEN [REDACTED] CAME TO THE DECK AREA, SHE DID NOT NOTICE ANYTHING UNUSUAL ABOUT HIM SUCH AS BLOOD ON HIS SHIRT AND PANTS AS REPORTED IN THE PRESS.

THEY WERE THEN ORDERED BACK DOWN TO THE LOUNGE AND IT APPEARED FROM WHAT PEOPLE WERE SAYING THAT THE SYRIANS WERE NOT ALLOWING THE SHIP TO DOCK. SHE IMMEDIATELY ASKED WHERE HER HUSBAND WAS. THE HIJACKERS WOULD NOT TELL HER. AT ONE POINT, ONE OF THE BRITISH GIRLS, WITH DARK HAIR, SAID HER HUSBAND HAD HEART PALPITATIONS AND HAD BEEN BROUGHT TO THE HOSPITAL.

FOR THE NEXT TWO DAYS, UNTIL THE HIJACKERS LEFT, SHE HAD NO

IDEA WHERE OR HOW HER HUSBAND WAS. AT ONE POINT, SHE ASKED THE HIJACKER WITH THE BEARD IF SHE COULD GO TO THE HOSPITAL TO SEE HIM BUT WAS TOLD NO. SHE THEN ASKED HIM IF HE WOULD GO AND CHECK ON HER HUSBAND AND TELL HER HOW HE WAS. HE SAID YES HE WOULD AND KISSED HER ON THE FOREHEAD. HE CAME BACK SHORTLY AND SAT IN THE CORNER OF THE LOUNGE CRYING WITH HIS HEAD DOWN. AFTER ABOUT 45 MINUTES WHEN HE COMPOSED HIMSELF, HE CAME OVER TO HER AND SAID HER HUSBAND WAS ALL RIGHT AND AGAIN KISSED HER ON THE FOREHEAD.

SHE BELIEVES HER HUSBAND WAS SINGLED OUT BECAUSE HE WAS THE WEAKEST. HE HAD HAD A STROKE SEVEN YEARS AGO AND WAS PARALYZED ON THE RIGHT SIDE. ALTHOUGH CONFINED TO A WHEELCHAIR, HIS MIND WAS CLEAR AND HIS SPEECH NORMAL. HE DID NOT HAVE TO BE STRAPPED IN THE WHEELCHAIR.

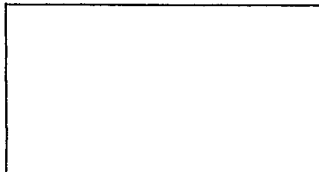
