PASFBA is a community-oriented organization established in 1964 which provides numerous social functions and services to thousands of Pakistanis living in the Bay Area. It also operates a weekly radio outreach program which

is broadcasted in the Urdu language called "Wattan-Ki Awaz" on Saturdays from 3-4pm. Each year in mid-August, the PASFBA also organizes the annual Pakistan Day Celebration which is held at the Golden Gate Park. The organization also holds other cultural and social programs throughout the year to bring the Pakistani community together.

[redacted] also noted that the FBI had a booth at last year's (August 19, 2007) 60th Pakistan Day Celebration which was held at the San Francisco Civic Center.

[redacted] added that the PASFBA is one of the largest Pakistani-based cultural and social organization in the SF Bay Area with access to Pakistani-oriented businesses, social and professional groups, as well as Islamic Centers, and other small mission-oriented Pakistani organizations.
